## **Municipal Ordinance No. 2014-017**

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING PRE-EMPTIVE OR FORCED EVACUATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO WHEN A DISASTER OR EMERGENCY OCCURS OR OCCURRED AND DANGER OF LIVES BECOME IMMINENT.

WHEREAS, it has been a national policy under Section 2 (a) of R.A. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the root causes of vulnerabilities to disaster,

strengthening the countries institutional capacity for Disaster Risk Reduction and Management and building the resilience of local communities to disaster including climate change impact;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Units (LGU) are authorized under Section 16 of Local Government Code of 1991, otherwise known as the "General Welfare" shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, all Local Chief Executives are mandated under the Local Government Code of 1991 to carry such emergency measure as may be necessary prior, during and in the aftermath of human induced and natural disaster or calamities.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit (LGU) through their Local Legislative Councils, are enjoined under DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2012-35 dated February 21, 2012 directing an LGU to enact Local Ordinance for the implementation of Forced Evacuation as a resort when a disaster or emergency is about to occur or occurred and danger of loss of lives is imminent within their areas of Jurisdiction.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tigbauan that:

**SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF POLICY** – It is the declared Policy in the Municipality of Tigbauan to protect the uses and properties of its residents at all times and to mitigate the effects of human-induced and natural disasters within the area of responsibility.

#### **SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS**

As used in this Ordinance:

**Disaster**- a serious disruption of the functioning of a community or a society involving widespread human, material, economic or environmental losses and impacts, which exceeds the ability of the affected community or society to cope using its own resources.

**Disaster Mitigation** - the lessening or limitation of the adverse impacts of hazards and related disasters. Mitigation measures encompass engineering techniques and hazard resistant construction as well as improved environmental policies and public awareness.

**Pre-Emptive or Forced Evacuation** - An order from competent authority to forcibly evacuate residents of Barangay to an appropriate evacuation destination to protect their lives during the onslaught of disaster.

*Emergency* - is a situation that poses an immediate risk to <u>health</u>, <u>life</u>, <u>property</u>, or <u>environment</u>.

**Evacuation** - means an operation whereby all or part of a particular population is temporarily relocated, whether individually or in an organized manner, from an area in which a disaster or emergency has been declared and is considered dangerous for health or safety of the public.

Imminent Danger - means immediate threats of harm.

**Livestock** - are <u>domesticated</u> <u>animals</u> raised in an agricultural setting to produce <u>commodities</u> such as <u>food</u>, <u>fiber</u> and <u>labor</u>.

*Municipal Waters* - refers to the sea area of a municipality.

**Storm Surge** - is a coastal <u>flood</u> or <u>tsunami</u>-like phenomena of rising water commonly associated with <u>low pressure</u> weather systems (such as <u>tropical cyclones</u> and strong <u>extra tropical cyclones</u>).

**Tsunami** - is a series of water waves caused by the displacement of a large volume of a body of water, generally an ocean or a <u>large lake</u>.

**SECTION 3.** GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURE ON FORCED EVACUATION- Upon the assessment or determination of the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) to implement or pre-emptive evacuation of the local resident is already necessary, the said council shall immediately make a recommendation of such assessment or determination.

The basis of such recommendation, the Municipal Mayor, who is also the Incident Commander, shall give order to the Punong Barangay to execute immediately the implementation of forced evacuation.

The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer (MDRRMO) will immediately assign responsibilities to the following:

- A.) PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) AND BARANGAY OFFICIALS AND TANODS- Shall enforce the implementation of forced evacuation and secure the safety of the evacuees.
- B.) BARANGAY OFFICIALS shall guide the evacuees to the designated evacuation centers and shall be responsible in the evacuation of livestock.
- C.) MUNICIPAL SOCIAL WELFARE DEVELOPMENT (MSWD) shall be responsible on the registration and assessment of the evacuees and prepare relief goods for distribution.
- D.) MUNICIPAL HEALTH OFFICE (MHO) shall be responsible for the health conditions of the evacuees.
- E.) MUNICIPAL ENGINEERING OFFICE shall be responsible for providing transportation to the evacuees and clearing operation after the disaster.
- $\hbox{F.)} \ \ \, \hbox{BUREAU OF FIRE \& RESPONDERS} \hbox{are tasked to response in any emergency or distress call.} \\$

However, immediately after the declaration of forced evacuation, before the actual implementation thereof, the Philippine National Police (PNP) or barangay tanod shall see to it that the local residents are informed in dialect known to them of the need to evacuate and that there is no other alternative way to ensure their safety.

SECTION 4. REFUSAL OF LOCAL RESIDENTS TO ABIDE BY THE DECLARATION OF FORCED EVACUATION OR GOING BACK TO THEIR RESPECTIVE HOMES WITHOUT AN ORDER ALLOWING THEM TO DO SO - In the event that local residents refuse to leave their homes, the Municipal Government as well as the members of the mobilized unit may use such reasonable force that is commensurate under the circumstances, to evacuate them from the area.

### **SECTION 6. SYSTEM OF EVACUATION**

1. First to evacuate are Persons With Disability (PWD), Pregnant Women, Senior Citizens, Children and persons with illness.

2. Advisory to bring basic and necessary things such as personal belongings like utensils, medicines available and beddings.

SECTION 7. EVACUATION OF LIVESTOCK - Livestock shall have separate evacuation centers or area as determined by barangay officials.

SECTION 8. PENALTY CLAUSE - Person violating any of the pertinent provisions of this Ordinance shall be subjected to a fine of not exceeding Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00) or imprisonment of not less than 6 months, at the discretion of the court.

If the violator is a public official, the foregoing penalty shall be without prejudice to administrative sanctions as may be imposed under existing laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - In the event any part or portion of this ordinance is declared to be illegal, unconstitutional or invalid, those parts or portions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be effective and enforceable.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE - Any prior ordinance, memorandum, rules and regulation which is inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed modified or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect upon compliance of the mandatory posting and publication requirement as prescribed under R.A. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 and upon approval.
